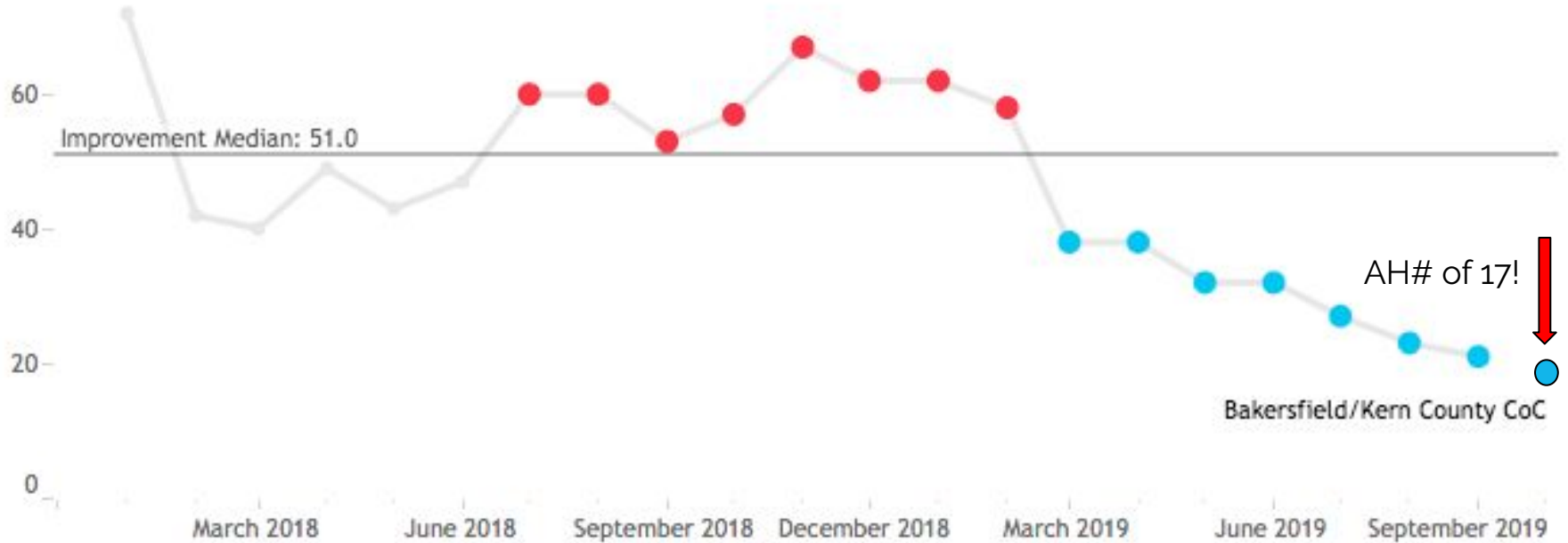

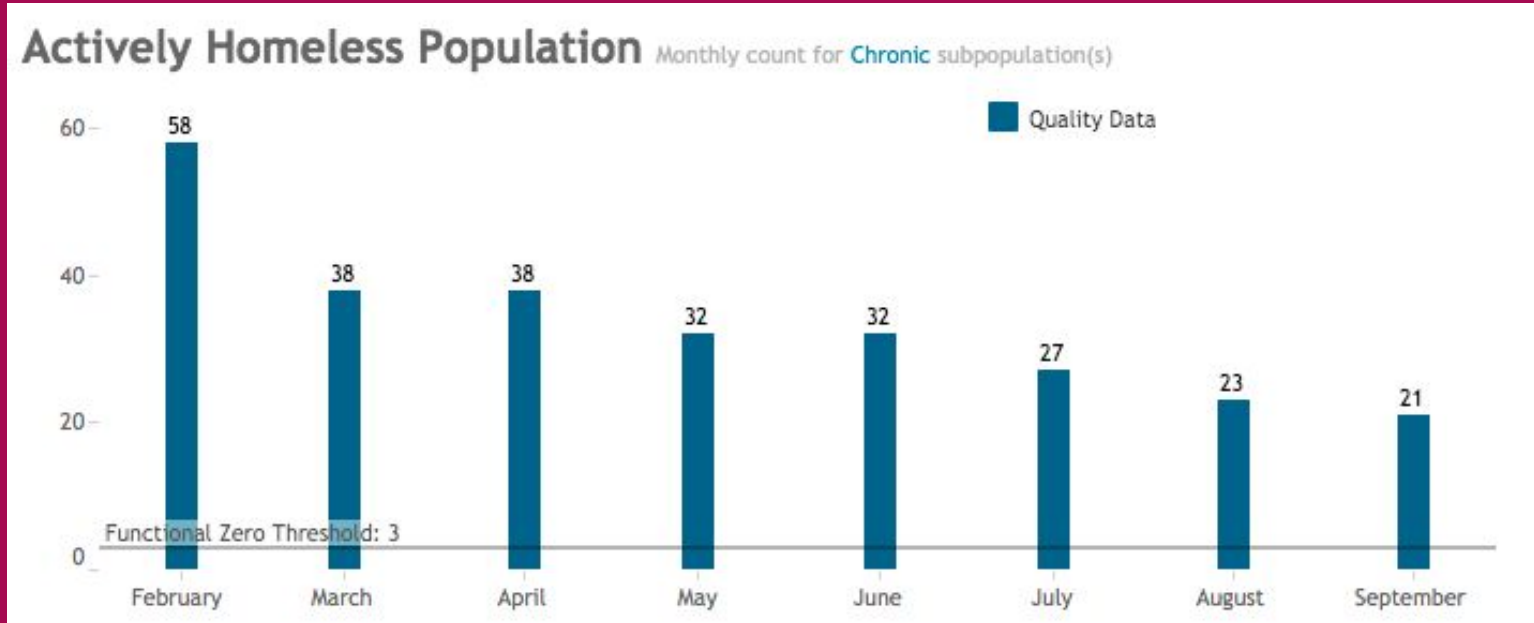
Bakersfield/Kern County, California

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Thinking Big

Provocation: What would it take to hit your next milestone 6 months from now and how might KP/State of CO invest or clear the path to help you get there?

Some framing:

Get in a 'what if?' mindset. Get outside the current status quo.

Consider time, talent and resources you might need or leverage

Be thinking about commitments you're ready to make leaving this room

Brainstorm in four categories:

1. Stakeholder Engagement/Political Will

- a. Ex. PHA or critical organizations at the table
- b. Ex. Engaging and aligning City/County Government

2. Capacity Building/Training/Facilitation

- a. Ex. Facilitate stakeholder meetings or process mapping
- b. Ex. Lean / QI training and expertise

3. Financial Investment

- a. Ex. Time-limited staffing
- b. Ex. Housing/Subsidy gap
